Girls School Junior Coach	1 training (before school) & 1 game (Wednesday)	2, 3	Ideally Junior Level 2 or equivalent (club can provide)
Boys School Junior Coach	1 training (Monday afternoon) & 1 game (Wednesday afternoon)	2, 3	Ideally Junior Level 2 or equivalent (club can provide)

Required Qualifications:

Coaches will have the following qualifications and experience:

- Preferred coaching qualifications as noted above, or aspiring to achieve them
- First Aid Certificate is preferable.
- NZ Police Vetting clearance (ACFC to complete) .

Required Skills:

Coaches will demonstrate and excel in the following fields:

- Delivery, execution and planning of high-quality sessions.
- Leadership – leading positivity by example (role model to players).
- Communication – effectively communicate to all parties associated to the team.
- Building effective working relationships – work successfully with others and show an ability to build and continue effective relationships with others.
- Management – be seen as an effective leader of players and people.
